- ★ Family drop off/pick up will be on Knapp - one way only - near the main doors.

Other communication from the school/district will be sent home with students or via email. Students are responsible for emptying out their home folder. Please help by

asking your child every day! It is up to each family how to practice academic organization.

Homework is to read 20 minutes every night and to check Seesaw nightly. One purpose of having a learning management system like Seesaw is for families to see student progress and talk about it at home. Also, if there is unfinished classwork, it will show up in Seesaw as a “draft,” and should be worked on at home until it’s completed.

- Snack **will not** be provided or shared - please bring from home.
- Outdoor recess will be **every day**. Please make sure appropriate clothing is brought every day and that your child can get dressed and undressed.
- Free breakfast and lunch provided every day. Milk is available for students bringing lunch from home for a small cost.
- iPads will remain at SAP for at least the first two weeks of school for inventory.
- Please send a water bottle with your child.

→ Please keep your child at home if they have symptoms of illness.

How can you help?

Make sure to read with your child every evening.

Make sure to talk about emotional and academic learning.

Make sure your child can blow their own nose.

Make sure to teach and model thorough hand washing.

Make sure your child can tie shoes.

Make sure your child can dress/undress themselves, including shoes, boots and winter gear.

Make sure your child can manage food/drink by themselves, including clean up if there’s a spill.

Make sure your child is at school by 7:15.

Make sure your child is picked up at 2:00 or knows the plan to get home.

Make sure to communicate with your child’s teacher with questions.
