



School Design Committee for St. Anthony Park Elementary

St. Anthony Park Elementary is starting the design process for a significant building renovation. SPPS recently completed its 10-year Facilities Master Plan (FMP) to ensure our school buildings are able to meet the 21st century learning needs of students, which identified a renovation of St. Anthony Park to be constructed starting in 2017 .

The anticipated scope of the project at SAP consists of:

- An instructional space and office addition, and a kitchen, food service addition.
- Extensive interior renovations of learning and support spaces.
- Renewal of mechanical and electrical systems that are reaching end of service life.

The anticipated schedule is to:

- Complete the conceptual design this school year.
- Seek competitive bids from construction firms in late 2016/early 2017.
- Start of construction in summer 2017.

We are looking for community members to participate in a School Design Committee to inform this exciting opportunity for St. Anthony Park Elementary. As we embark on this important project, which seeks to transform St. Anthony Park and align its building and site with current and future educational needs, we want to ensure that diverse perspectives inform its design.

The School Design Committee will be composed of district and academic leaders, teachers, students, families, community members and key partners. Through the guidance of the St. Anthony Master Plan, the School Design Committee will collaborate with the partnering architects on the conceptual design for the project.
