This year, we have three main areas of focus in our SCIP:

#### R E A D I N G

To raise student literacy growth by providing training and support in these areas:

- Project based learning at BTT. Direct Instruction at JDC.
- STAR reading assessment to determine pre and post instructional growth
- Flexible instructional groups to maximize individualized learning.
- Vocabulary studies, tests for contextual reading fluency, and comprehension.
- Accuplacer and Fusion reading interventions
- Increase volume of reading per District initiative

#### M A T H

To raise student math growth by providing training and support in these areas:

- STAR math assessment
- Mental Math / Math Review, Problem Solving, Conceptual Understanding, Master Facts
- Mixed group instruction with individualized learning
- Khan Academy, EdReady and APEX (researched based instructional design)

#### T R A N S I T I O N

To support the successful transition from placement back into the community by providing training and exposure in these areas:

- Counselor completes credit summary. Accurate and updated school transcripts
- Report special ed student performance quarterly; general ed at time of discharge.
- Development of an Individualized school transition plan
- Social skills, Life Skills, and emotional regulation
- Pre and post-release Navigator support
- Post-secondary career training through Career and Technical Educational (CTE) instruction and Naviance Lessons.
- Accuplacer Prep for credit recovery
