Library Skills

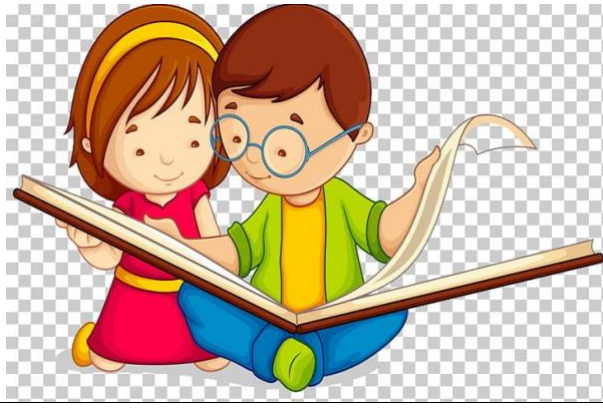
- I can find the everybody/easy books.
