## International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IB-PYP)

The goal of PYP is to provide a rigorous, global education that embraces inquiry-based teaching and learning with real life applications. It recognizes and addresses the importance of producing internationally-minded students who will be prepared for and be successful in a diverse market. This means our students think and act globally as they inquire, explore issues hands-on, reflect, and take action to solve problems.

### School Goals

**Reading:** The percentage of HPE students scoring proficient or higher in reading will increase by 5 percentage points from the 2021 scores in every student group by May 2022 as measured by the MCA Reading Test administered in April 2022.

**Math:** The percentage of HPE students scoring proficient or higher in math will increase by 5 percentage points from the 2021 scores in every student group by May 2022 as measured by the MCA Math Test administered in April 2022.

**Social Emotional Goal:** The percentage of students with more than two office discipline referrals will decrease from 5% to 2% as measured by the Campus behavior report by May 2022.

**As a Highland Park second grade teacher, I will:** work with students and their families to support student success in math and literacy. By the end of second grade students are expected to:

#### Math:

- Write addition and subtraction facts quickly
- Add & subtract two-digit numbers with regrouping
- Read and write numbers to 1,000
- Describe whole numbers in terms of place value
- Identify and find the value of a group of coins
- Tell time to the quarter-hour

#### Literacy:

- Read with fluency, accuracy, and comprehension at Fountas & Pinnell level M
  - Identify key ideas in the text
  - Determine the meaning of words and phrases used in the text
  - Use text features to locate information in text
  - Read and understand informational text
  - Begin each sentence with a capital letter and end each sentence with punctuation
  - Use letter sounds and word chunks to help with the spelling of words
  - Write neatly with capital & lower-case letters
- I will also:*
- Communicate with families at least biweekly to share information about our class in an electronic newsletter
  - Email all notices and information about classroom and school events in a timely fashion

**As a Highland Park student, I will:**

- Have my iPad charged and be ready to learn every day
- Work to the best of my ability
- Read for at least 20 minutes and complete my math homework every night
- Follow school and classroom essential agreements
- Find action steps to help HPE and our community

**As a Highland Park family, we will:**

- Make sure our child checks in with the school on time every day
- Call the school to report our child's absence
- Review our child's schoolwork and homework
- Read with our children every night
- Have fun with math – play games together, practice with flash cards, and use math in daily life
- Play word games with the new vocabulary words and find ways to use these words in family conversations
- Attend family fun nights when possible
- Attend conferences
- Attend PTA meetings when possible
- Volunteer at the school when possible
- Look for the class and school newsletters each month and check out the school website
- Read email communications from teachers, principal and the PTA
- Find action steps to help HPE and our community
