

Keeping Students Safe on the Bus

We are excited to welcome students back to school with hybrid learning.

Here are some of the health and safety practices that will be implemented when transporting students to and from school.

Health and Safety on the Bus

- K-12 students are expected to wear masks on the bus. Bus drivers have student masks available if needed.
- Drivers will wear masks
- Buses are disinfected daily
- Drivers will sanitize high-touch areas between runs

Please note: Students are not screened entering or exiting the bus. Do not send your students to the bus stop if they are sick.

Pre-K/ESCE Bus Loading/Drop-off

- Pre-K/ESCE students are not required to wear mask on the bus.
- School staff will monitor students getting on and off the bus to help maintain social distancing.

BUS SEATING CHART

1 or 2 students per seat, alternating rows. Students will be assigned seats. Students in the same family should share a seat.

BOARDING THE BUS

Students load the bus from back to front (first on sitting farthest back) with the exception of Pre-K/ECSE students.
