One Stop

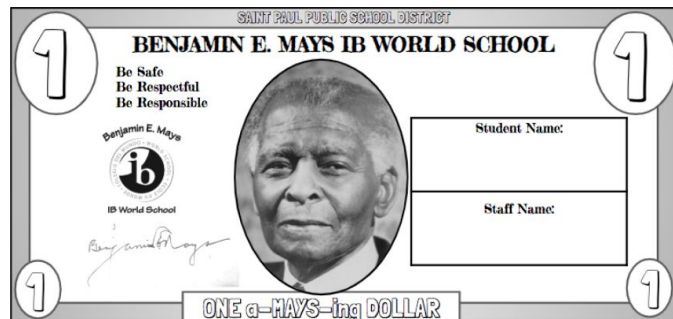
iUpdate is an online tool for parents/guardians to complete back-to-school forms, including contact and address changes, field trip forms and the Technology Use Agreement. iUpdate is accessed through One Stop on the St. Paul Public Schools website.

Parents and guardians need their username and password to access One Stop and iUpdate. The username is in the format of "gXXXXXX" or "g" followed by 6 numbers. It is assigned to you by district.
