Safety Rules

ALL PROJECTS MUST BE APPROVED

All experiments using animals should be careful not to cause harm or undue stress to the animal. Animals may not be displayed at the Science Fair, pictures and models are a good substitute. Exceptions may be granted with special permission.

No dangerous or combustible chemicals should be used at the fair or in home experiments. Rockets or engines must not contain fuel. All chemicals displayed must be sealed and clearly marked.

No open flames will be permitted.

All projects using electricity must conform to standard wiring practices and safety.

Collections (i.e. minerals and rocks, shells, feathers, etc.) can be protected with plastic coverings.

Batteries, wires, switches and/or motors must be adequately secured to the display.

All Science Fair project materials should be carefully packed when transporting them to the Science Fair.
