

Here is what you'll need to fill out the FAFSA:

1. **Your FSA ID*** - In order to sign our FAFSA electronically, you will need an FSA ID. You can help to prevent processing delays by getting an FSA ID before you begin the FAFSA.

Tip: Make sure to record all FSA ID passwords and security questions. They are case sensitive.

2. **Your social security number*** - If you are not a U.S. citizen, you will also need our Alien Registration Number
3. **Email Address***
4. **Your driver's license number** – If you don't have a driver's license, then don't worry about this step.
5. **Your tax records*** - Use income records from the 2016 tax year. If you filed your taxes for 2016 you may be able to automatically import your tax information into the FAFSA using the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool**. Tax records may include IRS forms 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ, and W-2 Forms.
6. **Records of your untaxed income*** Records and documentation of other untaxed income received such as welfare benefits, child support, Social Security income, veteran's benefits, military or clergy allowances, etc.
7. **Records of all your assets*** This includes savings and checking account balances, certificates of deposit, 529 plans and other college savings programs, as well as investments such as stocks, bonds, real estate, business or farms.
8. **List of the school(s) you are interested in attending** – We will use your FAFSA information to determine the types and amounts of financial aid you may receive.

****If you are a dependent student, you will need this information for your parent(s) as well.***
