School Continuous Improvement Plan (SCIP)

MCA - Reading - SMART Goal *The passing rate of Language Arts courses required for graduation in grades 9th will increase from 75% to 95% and 10th 68% to 90% respectively as monitored quarterly and measured by Final Marks report in BOLT by June 2023.*

MCA - Math - SMART Goal *The passing rate of Mathematics courses required for graduation in grades 9th (30% receive NC) from 70% to 90% and 10th (appx. 30% receive NC) will increase 69% to 90% respectively as monitored quarterly and measured by Final Marks report in BOLT by June 2023.*

9th Grade Credit Attainment 100% of Check and Connect mentors will mentor 3 or more ninth graders as measured by the Check & Connect Coordinator by 10/30/2021.
