It has been a great year at Johnson Senior High School and I am excited to share with you that we have much to look forward to over the next few years. Johnson will be receiving significant building updates as the result of direct feedback from Johnson's Facilities Master Plan community workshops and previously planned building maintenance.

These renovations will make Johnson safer, healthier, and more efficient and welcoming for staff, students and the community.

The work will be done in two phases:

**Phase 1: Summer 2016**

New boilers

New roof

New fire alarm system

Plumbing replacement/new single-occupancy restrooms

**Phase 2: Summer 2017**

Building addition with new front entry

Replacement of flooring, ceiling, paint and lighting in the cafeteria and corridor

Johnson's upcoming renovations will include a building addition that will provide a secure front entry, additional classrooms and more support space for the students and staff. The current restrooms will be changed to a single-occupancy model that will be cleaner, more accessible and safer for everyone using the facilities.

The planned maintenance work will replace worn-out electrical systems that will increase the efficiency of the building and improve Johnson's learning environment.

I invite you to our parent/teacher conferences on Thursday, May 5, to discuss the updates with our Facilities Department and students involved in the planning committees.
