Behavior Support Team (BST) will meet weekly to review data and monitor Tier 1 progress.</p>
	<p>Math Goal</p> <p>How will we reach our Math Goal?</p>	<p>The percentage of all student scoring proficient or higher in mathematics will increase from 26% to 30% by spring 2021 as measured by the MCA III Math Assessment administered in April 2021.</p> <p>Teachers will implement SPPS Math Differentiates small group per SPPS practice profile.</p> <p>Professional development will be provided to grade levels. Instructional coach will share monthly progress and coaching will be available to support staff.</p>
	<p>Reading Goal</p> <p>How will we reach our Reading Goal?</p>	<p>The percentage of all students scoring proficient or higher in reading will increase from 23% to 28% by Spring 2021 as measured by the MCA III Reading Assessment administered in April 2021.</p> <p>Teachers will be provided professional development in reading. Instructional coach will share monthly progress and coaching will be available to support staff.</p>
	<p>Title One: What you need to know?</p> <p>Bruce F. Vento Elementary School receives federal Title One funds to supplement its annual budget and to support increase student achievement. Most of our Title One funds are spent to support students who need extra help and for staff who target improved learning and increased parent involvement.</p>
