- Please reflect on what values you bring to personal and community leadership.
- What is a concept, idea or topic that makes you lose track of time, and why?
- What does community mean to you?
- How would you describe St. Paul as you know it? How would you describe your experience?

You can choose to discuss your topic using any of the following:

- Video essay (3 minute maximum)
- Poem, video recorded spoken word or song (1 page or 3 minute maximum)
- Any 2 or 3D imagery (1 paragraph written explanation must accompany the image)
- Written essay (1 page maximum)

The medium you choose should be the one you feel you can best express yourself in and will not affect how your application is reviewed. Written submissions can be in the language you feel best able to express yourself. The review committee will have your submission translated for review.

Application deadline is 5 p.m. on May 3.
