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Looking Ahead

Reading: Students have been listening to stories read to them. They have been practicing on reading independently and building stamina.

Writing: Students have been drawing and writing stories about school and home. Some stories they have been working on are about their family, what they like to do and what they like to eat. Students are learning how to add more details to their drawing and writing a sentence to match their drawing.

Skills: Students have been reviewing the alphabet letters c,d,f,h,k,l,m,n,p,q,r,s,t,v,x,y and z in Hmong. We will be focusing on each Individual letter.
