### HAVE YOU APPLIED FOR FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEALS?

### DO YOU HAVE AN ACTIVE EBT CARD?

### DO YOU HAVE CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 5 IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD?

WIC is a U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) program that helps eligible pregnant women, new mothers, babies and children up to age 5 stay healthy. WIC services are available to income eligible residents. WIC clinics in Ramsey County are open Monday through Friday, except holidays. Call (651) 266-1300 to schedule an appointment.

### DO YOU HAVE ANYONE 60 OR OLDER IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD?

NAPS program participants are given a box of highly nutritious food that may include canned fruits, vegetables and juices, milk, cheese, canned meat, peanut butter or dried beans, cereal, rice or pasta. Participants must be low-income (at 130% poverty level), Minnesota residents 60 years of age or older. Hunger Solutions has several comprehensive maps that connect individuals and families with food resources, including delivery options for those who are home bound.

To search for food resource locations close to your home, type your address in the box on the left hand side that says, "Enter location". You can also indicate which type of food resource you would like to find. There are food shelves, senior resources, farmers markets, free meals, discount grocery, and community food distributions.

Only a click away, the Free Meals for Kids mobile app will help families and kids find free meals at schools and other sites across Minnesota during school closures. How it works: 1. Download the Free Meals for Kids app to your cell phone. 2 Use the app to find the nearest site providing meals and meal packs by GPS. 3 Click on the nearby site and use the Meals Updates tab for more details.
