Capitol Hill Magnet School is a full-time academically gifted and talented program for students in grades 1 – 8. Learners experience a challenging academic program designed to develop skills in critical and creative thinking. Acceleration (fast-paced learning) combined with complex content allow for in-depth study through the joy of learning, kindness, wellness and student voice.

The mission of Capitol Hill Magnet School is “**challenging academically gifted and talented students in a diverse school community.**”

**Capitol Hill Gifted and Talented Magnet School, Grades 1-8, is focused on continuous growth for all students. The three components of gifted, equity and wellness are integrated, deepened and differentiated within the school curriculum and instruction.**

Reading MCA goal:

The percentage of **3rd-8th grade students** scoring proficient or higher in **reading** will increase from 72% to 78% by **April 2016** as measured by the MCA III administered by the state.

Math MCA Goal:

The percentage of **3rd-8th grade students** scoring proficient or higher in **math** will increase from 70% to 78% by **April 2016** as measured by the MCA III administered by the state.

Social Emotional Goal:

Students will show an increased level of self-advocacy, greater individual responsibility, higher incidences of constructive decision making and self-regulation, resulting in a highly engaging learning environment.
