**To enroll your child in EDL, fill out this form and return to the Capitol Hill office by Friday, September 30th, 2016. Student enrollment is based on when EDL registration is received. Classes must have an enrollment of at least 20 students or they will be cancelled.**

- EDL takes place two days per week, Tuesday and Thursday, from 3:00-4:45pm -- and is free of cost.
- The classes are held at Capitol Hill. An afternoon snack and bus transportation home are included.
- Students gather right after school in the Blue Cafeteria on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

#### **Storytelling and Bookmaking (Grades 3&4)**

Students will experience joy and excitement in illustrating and writing their own stories. They will be introduced to various methods of book making through the use of different genres poetry, fantasy, fiction, autobiography, comics, and satire.

#### **Computer Coding (Grades 3&4)**

Students will learn computer coding in applications, such as MIT created SCRATCH, in order to develop an understanding of how sandbox video games like Minecraft are designed and programmed.

#### **Art Around the World (Grades 3&4)**

Traditional visual art projects from around the world will be used to help students learn about different countries, cultures, and history. Such projects also teach that there is more to the world than our own community.

#### **Hmong Language Class (Grades 5-8)**

This class will explore the foundations of Hmong language with a native Hmong speaker. Students will also experience some Hmong cultural themes including the opportunity to learn about Hmong musical instruments.

#### **Roleplaying Games (Grades 5-8)**

Tabletop roleplaying games bring players together to collaboratively tell a story. Practice creative storytelling (mixed with a little math) to create a world of your own for adventurous exploration. A roll of the dice and your wits will guide you.

#### **First Tech Challenge (Grades 6-8)**

Teams design, build, and program a robot to compete in an alliance format against other teams. FTC teaches teenagers the importance of working together, sharing ideas and treating each other with respect and dignity.
