What does CogAT7 mean?

Cognitive Abilities Test Form 7. The seven means that it is the seventh version of the assessment. The test has three sections that are described below.

VERBAL:

This section of the test includes:

- Verbal Analogies (Example, foot is to shoe as hand is to ...)
- Sentence Completion (Example, Which one swims in the ocean?)
- Verbal Classification (Example, grouping objects that go together)

QUANTITATIVE:

This section of the test includes:

- Number Analogies
- Number Puzzles
- Number Series

NONVERBAL:

This section of the test includes:

- Figure Matrices
- Paper Folding
- Figure Classification

What do the results mean?

The CogAT7 assessment allows us to learn about how your child thinks and learns. The information gathered from the assessment shares information about a student's reasoning abilities.
