### Kindergarten Academic Expectations for FALL:

**Literacy** - Know letter names and begin learning letter sounds. Pre-reading skills.

**Math**- Be able to count, read, write, and show one to one correspondence up to 10.

### Reading

Students have been working on matching the pictures to the words in a book and identifying the sight words we have been learning.

Sight words:

A, see, the, I, me, he, go, we, it, an, can, in, no, up, look, at, be, to, for, make, am, are, my

New Sight Words:

is, come, like, so

### Writing

Students have been telling/drawing/writing topics they know about. We have focused on writing their name at the top of the paper, drawing a sketch of their ideas and adding a sight word (I, A, Me). We also encourage writing beginning sounds of words they want to share.

### Math

Students have been working on reading and writing numbers 0-10. We are also learning to count forward and backwards from 10. We are learning tricky teen numbers 11-20 and learning about AB patterns.
