

Winter Break Is Here!

Winter break is here! Check out these ideas for at home reading and math practice. Math Practice Ideas

- Set aside 5 - 10 minute math facts practice daily
- Use flashcards (your child's teacher can help with that) or your child's favorite math app •
- Play board games like: Monopoly, Life, Payday, Rummikub and Candyland - Play the "Guess my number game" – It's easy! Here's an example: I'm thinking of a number that is even. I'm thinking of a number that is a multiple of 5. When you add 9 to this number you get 19. What's my number?
- Give your child a handful of coins to count. If you don't have coins, draw small circles and fill them with the coin quantity such as 1, 5, 10, and 25 cents. Have them help you add up the money and estimate how much the groceries will cost at the grocery store. Practicing counting money will help them in school and in life outside of school. - Practice telling time on an analog clock. Many students struggle with the minute and hour hand. Reading Practice Ideas • Set a reading time every night. - Enjoy reading together! - Visit the library and make it a routine to go there!
