

Winter Weather Plan

The safety and well-being of students and staff is the top priority of SPPS and the decision to close school is no simple matter. Our commitment is to keep families, staff and the community informed of weather-related school closings and cancellations. Please note that we continually monitor the forecast from the National Weather Service in order to make the best decision for students, staff and families. Additionally, delayed start times are not logistically possible in Saint Paul

Public Schools. Beginning this winter, schools will keep students inside if the wind chill is expected to be colder than -10 degrees below zero. Regardless of the wind chill, students who do not have the appropriate winter clothing will not be able to participate in outdoor recess. Please review our clothing guidelines for cold weather

COLD CONDITIONS

Temperature or wind chill. School will be canceled if the expected forecast for 6 a.m. the following morning shows: o Wind chill is below -35 degrees Fahrenheit **OR** Air temperature is below -25 degrees Fahrenheit. The decision will be made by 6:30 p.m. the night before a cancellation.

SNOWY CONDITIONS

Snow, ice or hazardous road conditions. School will be canceled if heavy snow and/or icy conditions make it extremely hazardous or impossible for school buses to travel their routes and for employees to get to work safely. The decision will be made by 5 a.m. the morning of a cancellation.
