Crossroads Science is focused on raising the achievement scores for each student. Strengthening differentiation within instruction is an area of focus. Some of the ways this will be done are:

READING

- Implementation of MONDO Phonics curriculum with fidelity to students based on student data in grades K – 1
- Implementation of Mondo Phonics Intervention curriculum (2-3) or Hybrid Phonics Program (4-5) with fidelity to students based on student data
- Implementation of differentiated small group instruction during the 30-minute skills block

MATH

- Implementation of Math Part 1 and 2 during the math block, which includes flex groups and Task Board activities based on grade level benchmarks and individual student needs as determined by pre and post math unit assessments
- Implementation of daily Math Review, which includes a prescribed structure for engaging students in the practice of number sense problems
- Implementation of SPPS Math Fact Curriculum, with fidelity as evidenced by the math facts data wall

English Language Learners (ELL)

- Implementation of ELL instructional strategies with a focus on academic language and the use of sensory and visual supports

Culture, Climate & Behavior

- Execution of culturally relevant lessons that include the tenants of rigorous instruction, strong relationships between staff and students, realness of lesson content, and relevance of content to real life
- Proactive approach to discipline, which includes the Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) model along with student interventions to promote success and more time in the classroom
