



Extended Day for Learning (EDL) Program Secondary Schools

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Your child is invited to enroll in the Extended Day for Learning (EDL) after school program. Students who participate in EDL have opportunities to:

- Improve reading and/or math skills using alternative curriculum and instruction
- Engage in fun, creative, and active learning
- Increase English speaking and reading skills
- Graduation preparation (Grades 9 & 10)

This FREE program runs two or four days per week for one hour and 45 minutes at most schools (schedule and calendar document enclosed) and includes:

- A snack
- Bus transportation home for grades 6-8 students living more than 1 mile from school
- Metro Transit bus tokens are provided for transportation home for student in grades 9-12
- The SPPS EDL program operates in collaboration with the 21st Century Grant Program in some SPPS schools, the combination of the two programs is referred to as Flipside in some buildings.

FLIPSIDE PROGRAM (High School) REGISTRATION HOW-TO GUIDE

- Make sure you have completely filled out the “Personal Information” section.
- You do not need to attend the FLIPSIDE program on all 4 days. You can choose to only attend 2 days if you’d like.
- If you are only going to attend on 2 days, DO NOT select any clubs on the days that you will not be attending FLIPSIDE.
- If the club that you are selecting is 2 hours long, write the name of the club in both the 1st Hour and 2nd Hour slot.
- If any of the clubs you select are full, then the FLIPSIDE Director will talk to you about choosing another club.
- Once you turn in your FLIPSIDE registration form, you will receive a copy of your actual FLIPSIDE schedule one week before the program begins.
