Four Seasons A+ is focused on raising the achievement scores for each student. Strengthening differentiation within instruction that fully integrates the arts is an area of focus. Some of the ways this will be done are:

Reading

- Implementation of effective strategies for learning academic language to increase student to student talk in guided reading lessons.
- Implementation of core academic components for strategies to “Reading the Text” to increase academic achievement.

Math:

- Increase the implementation of academic language needs in math instruction.
- Implementation of the math curriculum at differentiated levels to meet the academic needs of individual students.

PBIS:

- Continue to implement proactive approach to discipline, which includes the Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) model along with student interventions to promote success and more time in the classroom.
- Implementation of Tier 2 systems and interventions, with an emphasis on decision rules as well as increasing communication of systems to staff and families.
