

## **Summary of Chelsea Height's 2018-2019 School Comprehensive Improvement Plan (SCIP)**

Each school is required to develop a SCIP plan to organize goals and to align resources for student achievement. Staff develops the SCIP with input from parents based on student need. The SCIP includes Overview, Data, Analysis, Goals, Strategies, Aligned Learning, Title 1, Family Engagement and Assurances.

**MISSION STATEMENT:** We develop and enhance the love of learning in all students, creating a partnership connecting home, school and community.

### **SCIP GOALS:**

**MCA Reading SMART Goal:** The percentage of students scoring proficient or higher in reading will increase from 49% to 53% by Spring 2019 as measured by the MCA.

**MCA Math SMART Goal:** The percentage of students scoring proficient or higher in math will increase from 49% to 54% by Spring of 2019 as measure by MCA.

### **TITLE 1 FUNDS:**

Chelsea Heights is allocated \$111,000 (Total budget \$2.8 million) in Title 1 funds. The majority of the Title 1 funds are spent for staffing. An intervention specialist and Kindergarten paraprofessional position are paid for out of Title 1. Two hourly teachers are also hired to work with struggling students in reading and math.

### **FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PLAN:**

Chelsea Heights supports parents by responding to their needs and interests. Monthly Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) meetings are held on the second or third Tuesday of each month. Parent-Teacher conferences are held during November and March. Parents are encouraged to be involved in our school community.
